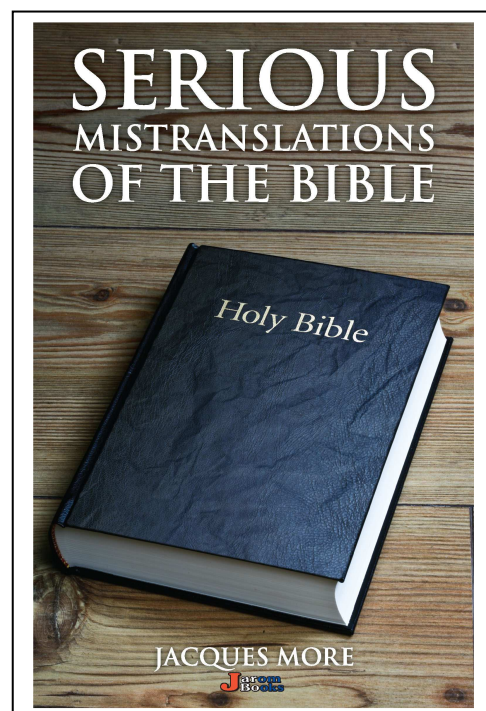


# DID YOU KNOW?

Was the Greek version of the Old Testament?

There you read:

The FAT cows coming out of the Nile  
(in Pharaoh's dream) are EKLEKTOS cows  
The FAT kernels of wheat are EKLEKTOS wheat.  
Young men – guys in their prime –  
They are EKLEKTOS (often)  
PLEASANT land – EKLEKTOS  
HIGHEST branches - EKLEKTOS  
RICH apparel – EKLEKTOS  
With the PURE you will show yourself PURE – EKLEKTOS  
Many more...



Is it any wonder when you read Jesus saying "many are called, few EKLEKTOS"

It is better translated "few are fit for the calling" "few are up to it"

e.g. "**Many are called, few have mettle**" Matthew 20:16 – Matthew 22:14 JM

**23 places** in the New Testament "**chosen**" and "**elect**" from EKLEKTOS

**= A SERIOUS MISTRANSLATION**

Then there is the word GENEVA with 2 meanings.

A GENERATION

A GROUP (related)

ADDED words not warranted

BIAS in translation to favour a doctrine

52 Bible passages covered
